Our Mandate

The St Andrew's Old Girls' Association is a registered public benefit and non-profit organisation. The main aims of the Association include:

- to further the interests of the pupils of the School;
- to foster and maintain the interest of the alumni in ongoing work and life of the School;
- to raise funds to assist generally with education and development relating to the School, and specifically, including amongst other aspects:
 - the establishment, granting and administration of bursaries;
 - the provision of furnishing and equipment for the School premises ;
 - laying out, beautifying and equipping of School grounds; and
- to maintain contact with Ordinary Members and assist members to contact each other and to maintain a spirit of fellowship amongst each other.

Annual Events

We have approximately 3,700 members recorded and actively engage with our network throughout the year. Some of the events that we host annually include:

- Reunions in Johannesburg, Durban, Cape Town, and from time to time, also abroad;
- Business Network functions;
- AGM; and
- Fundraising Events.

Beneficiaries

All proceeds from these events assist us in meeting our mandate. Apart from the School itself, funds are raised for bursaries which are given to daughters / grand-daughters of Old Girls, who are pupils at the School and in financial need. In addition to this we also support uBambiswano - an outreach initiative established by the school which supports learners from Daveyton and Etwatwa - and the St Andrew's Heritage Foundation which aims to ensure that the School has the capacity to remain an outstanding educational institution for girls.

Opportunities to Support Us

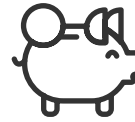

We support Old Girl run businesses



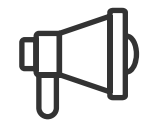
